Emily Jo was hired as the Assistant Executive Director at RPI in 2020 and was selected by the RPI Board of Directors in 2021 to serve as their Executive Director.

After receiving her B,A. in women's studies from St. Bonaventure University she was a farm to table summer intern at the Franciscan Center for Social Concern at St. Bonaventure

University in Olean, New York.

Relocating to our community, she began work on her graduate studies at the Institute for Nonprofit Administration & Research (INAR) at LSUS. While there she was a graduate assistant and an exam proctor while also beginning her volunteer internship at Renesting Project.

During the worst of the pandemic, Emily started a blog (with her as the primary author and graphic designer) to continue to stay true to the Renesting Mission and to continue to serve clients.


