ABOUT THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE

The National Weather Service in Shreveport is one of 122 weather forecast offices around the country. There are also 13 river forecast centers, 9 national centers, and other support offices. There are regional headquarters in Kansas City, Missouri; Bohemia, New York; Fort Worth, Texas; Salt Lake City, Utah; Anchorage, Alaska; and Honolulu, Hawaii. The national headquarters for the NWS is located in Silver Spring, Maryland. The NWS employs 4,000+ employees. The NWS provides a national infrastructure to gather and process weather and climate data worldwide. Each day, NWS collects some 6.3 billion observations, and each year issues approximately 1.5 million forecasts and 50,000 warnings. The NWS is a part of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA), which is also a part of the Department of Commerce.
