Jennifer L. Marusak was named Executive Director of the Ports Association of Louisiana in 2018. In addition to joining the association management team, Marusak leads PAL’s governmental affairs and lobbying efforts. She is also tasked with partnering with the local port representatives to implement an effective grassroots strategy with civic organizations that will showcase Louisiana ports to the Legislature and community stakeholders.

Governor John Bel Edwards appointed Marusak to the Louisiana River Pilot Oversight Board in 2021.

Marusak was previously vice president of governmental affairs for the Louisiana State Medical Society. She also owns and has operated “On Track with Marusak” since 2000 —the longest operating online news clipping service in the state.

She served on the Louisiana State Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Board of Directors for 13 years, two of those as chair.

The Natchitoches native holds a B.A. in criminal justice and a master’s degree in mass communication from ULM.

Eric England is the Executive Port Director of the Caddo-Bossier Parishes Port Commission and has served in this role since 2005. He leads all Port activity within the Port area, an area comprised of the entire Parishes of Caddo and Bossier.

In 2004 Eric received the Professional Port Manager designation from the American Association of Port Authorities.

A veteran, Eric enlisted in the LA Army National Guard while a junior at Capt. Shreve High School and served with the 1st Battalion 156th Armor Division during Desert Shield/Desert Storm. He received his bachelor’s and master’s degrees from Louisiana Tech University.



From the time that he and his partner bought a franchise for Preferred Care at Home in 2012, he has dedicated his time and energy to the care, comfort, safety and happiness of senior citizens. Through his business he is able to ensure that seniors in his community can safely age in place while maintaining their dignity and independence. He maintains an insurance license specializing in long term care policies, guiding and advising anyone who needs assistance in working to claim benefits or handling problems with insurance companies. Robert's true passion lies within the area of Alzheimer's and dementia. He serves as the President of the Board of Directors for The Bridge Alzheimer's and Dementia Resource Center in Shreveport, Louisiana. Robert's five-year guidance and leadership of the organization has brought The Bridge from an all-volunteer organization with a \$5,000 budget to a robust organization of three full-time and three part-time employees. The 2022 budget is just short of \$400,000 and they have touched over 4,000 individuals in the last year alone. Smith says, "The rewards and joy I have gotten from my involvement with this organization has solidified the knowledge that I am where I need to be in my life and am making a difference in my community for countless families and seniors during their most vulnerable times."
