Keynote

LSU Health Shreveport Chancellor



On January 4, 2023, LSU Health Shreveport announced that Dr. David Guzick is assuming the position as chancellor of their organization and will also oversee the campus at Monroe, LA.

Guzick is a member of the country's premier honorific society for medical scientists and leaders, the National Academy of Medicine. He is a renowned clinician, medical scientist and health economist with expertise in the field of reproductive medicine

including polycystic ovary syndrome, endometriosis and infertility.

He was awarded with the "Best Physician for Women" recognition by Good Housekeeping and is a recipient of the Roy M. Pitkin Award for the best paper published in the journal Obstetrics and Gynecology. Dr. Guzick also earned "Top Paper of the Decade in Reproductive Medicine" from the Serono Symposium International Foundation for his 2020 book entitled "US Health Care Industry: Balancing Care, Cost and Access".

Dr. Guzick's most recent position was at the University of Florida where he served as senior vice president of health affairs and president of UF Health for nine years. Prior to that time, he served for seven years as dean of the University of Rochester School of Medicine and Dentistry.

He received his M.D. and PhD from New York University as part of the NIH Medical Scientist Training Program. He completed his residency in obstetrics and gynecology at The Johns Hopkins Hospital and his fellowship in reproductive endocrinology at The University of Texas, Southwestern Medical Center.





