Coach Steve Tucker, a native of Long Beach, Mississippi and a graduate of Mississippi College, was one of the youngest head coaches in the nation in college basketball at the age of 22, when he was named head coach at Phillips College.

At the age of 28, he became one of the youngest head coaches on the NCAA Division I level ever, when he was named the head coach at Sam Houston State University.

When the Mavericks Pro Basketball Team was previously in Shreveport, Coach Tucker led them to a 66-0 record during the 2014-2015/2013-2014 seasons to become the only team to have back-to-back undefeated regular seasons and the only back-to-back undefeated Champions in Pro Basketball history.

The Mavericks were voted the Sports Team of the Year in 2016 by the Owensboro Community Magazine for its work on and off the court. In April 2017, the Mavericks decided to cease operations and go dark. It was the end of one of the best runs by any Professional Basketball Organization/Team in the world of professional basketball and it was truly a sad occasion.

After three years of being dormant, the Mavericks have returned to Shreveport to play in the Centenary Gold Dome. Pat Booras, the owner of the Mavericks, is a lifelong Shreveport-Bossier resident, who is committed to bringing the best product he can to the citizens of Shreveport-Bossier. He was named one of the most fascinating people of Shreveport in 2017.


